Nanny called out, "Billy, have you seen a sheep called Ewe?"


"Who me, no I haven't seen Ewe, Sorry" Said Billy.


"Thank you anyways" said Ram as he turned and slowly walked away.

"Have you seen Ewe" asked Ram


"have I seen me"






Stag, have you seen a sheep called Ewe?"

"No," said Drake, "I haven't seen any sheep by the lake. I'll ask Duck, With any luck she might have seen a sheep called Ewe."






Drake called out, "Duck, have you seen a sheep called Ewe by the lake?" "Not today Drake" replied Duck, "Maybe try by the farmhouse".
"Thank you" said Ram as he turned and walked to the farmhouse.


By the Farmhouse, Ram meets a mouse.

"Hello there" said Ram, "I hope you can help, I'm looking for Ewe".


The horse looks at Ram and thought for a second,

"Indeed I do" said Mare, "she went toward the lake".








"Well if you hurry quickly, you might catch her there" Said Mare. Ram hurried as fast as he could towards the lake.






"No Drake, after I left the lake I went to the farmhouse and saw a mouse, the mouse sent me past the village fare, where I met Mare,

Drake paused for a second, and said



"WAIT" Quacked Duck.


"You'll both be running around in circles all day if you go that way, instead you should head back to the village fair and back to Mare, surely the mouse by the farmhouse will send her there".
