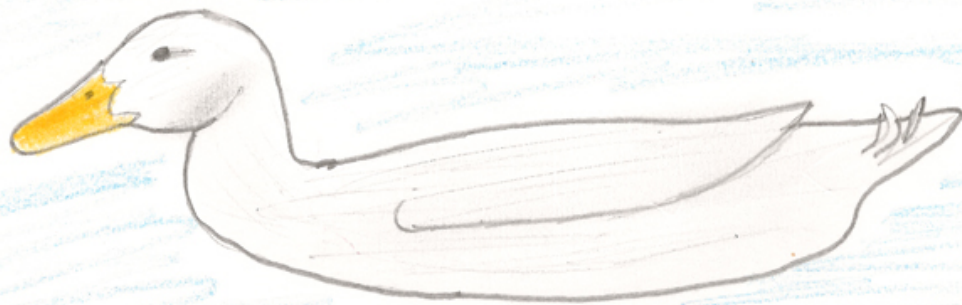


# The Duck That Loves Cheese

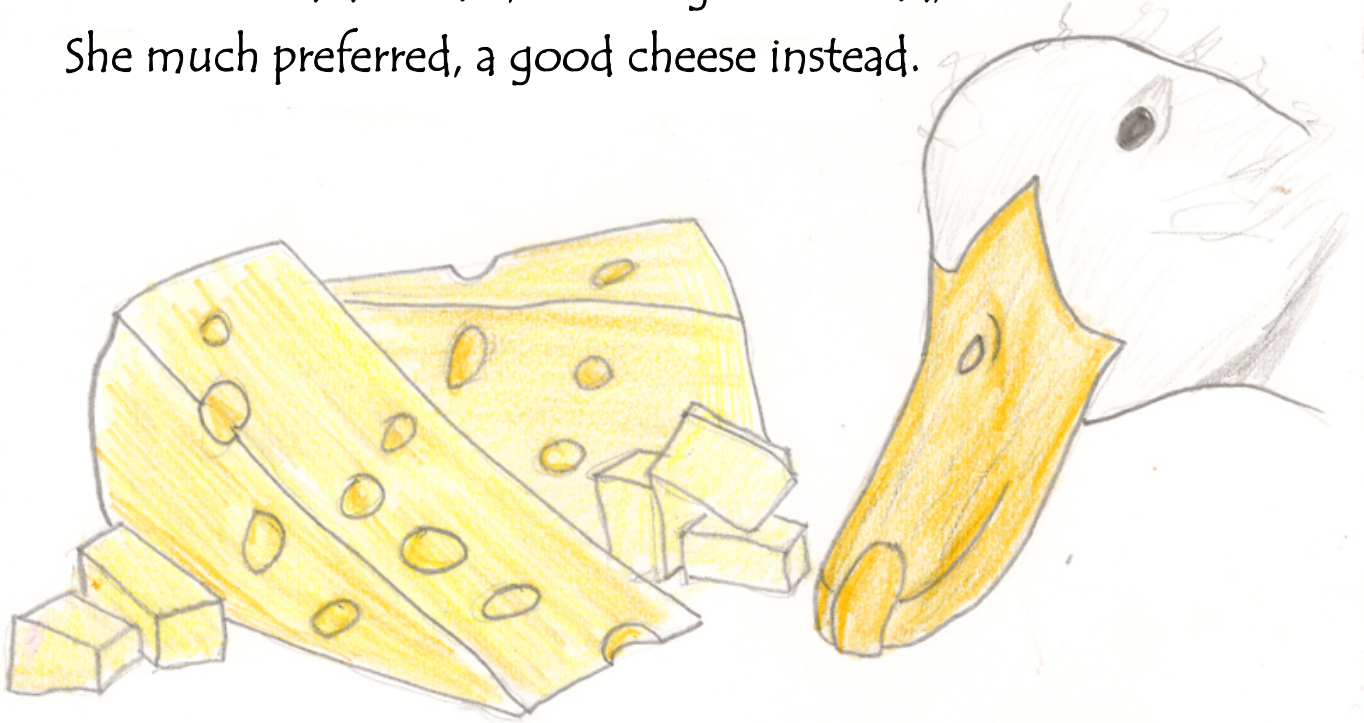

She had white feathers, that were all really messy.



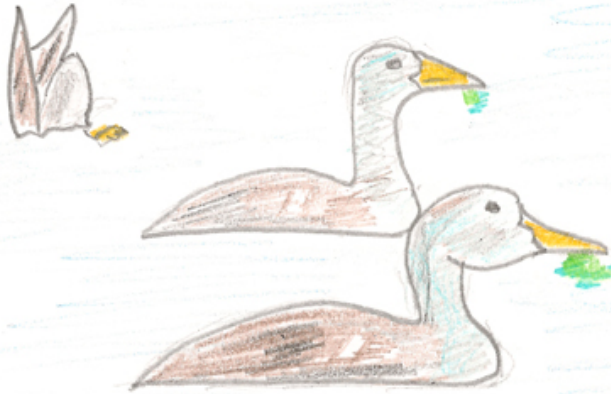
Now Jessie didn't care, for things like bread,

As Jessie drank, her herbal infusion.

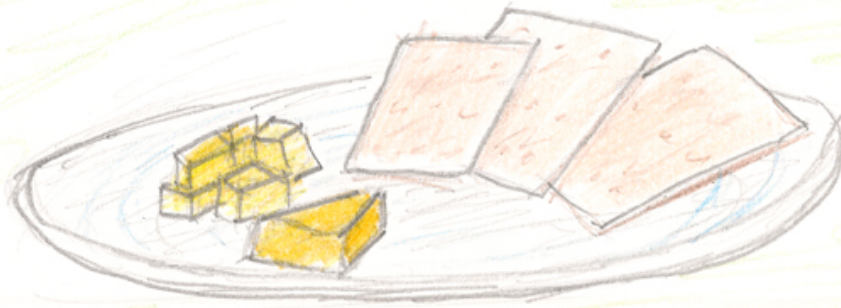




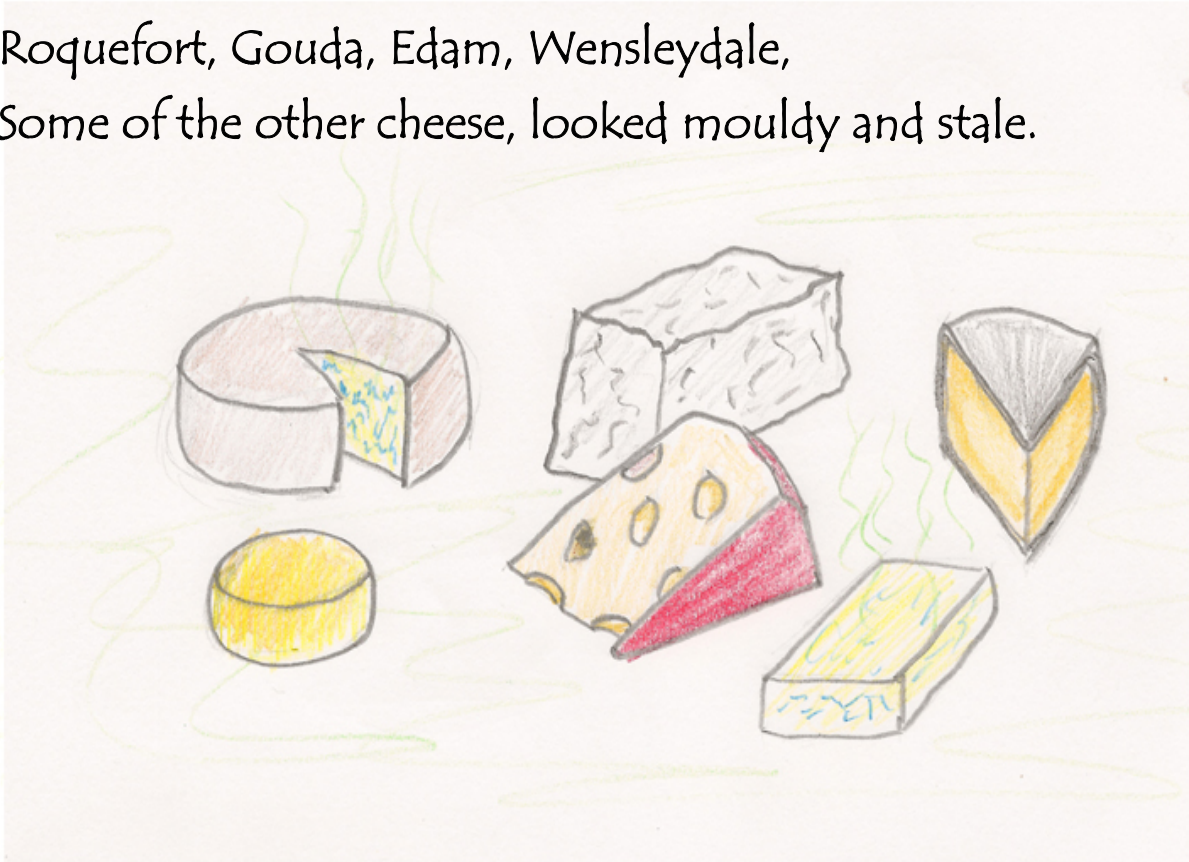
Jessie proclaimed that there was nothing finer,  
Than drinking tea, in her best Bone China.



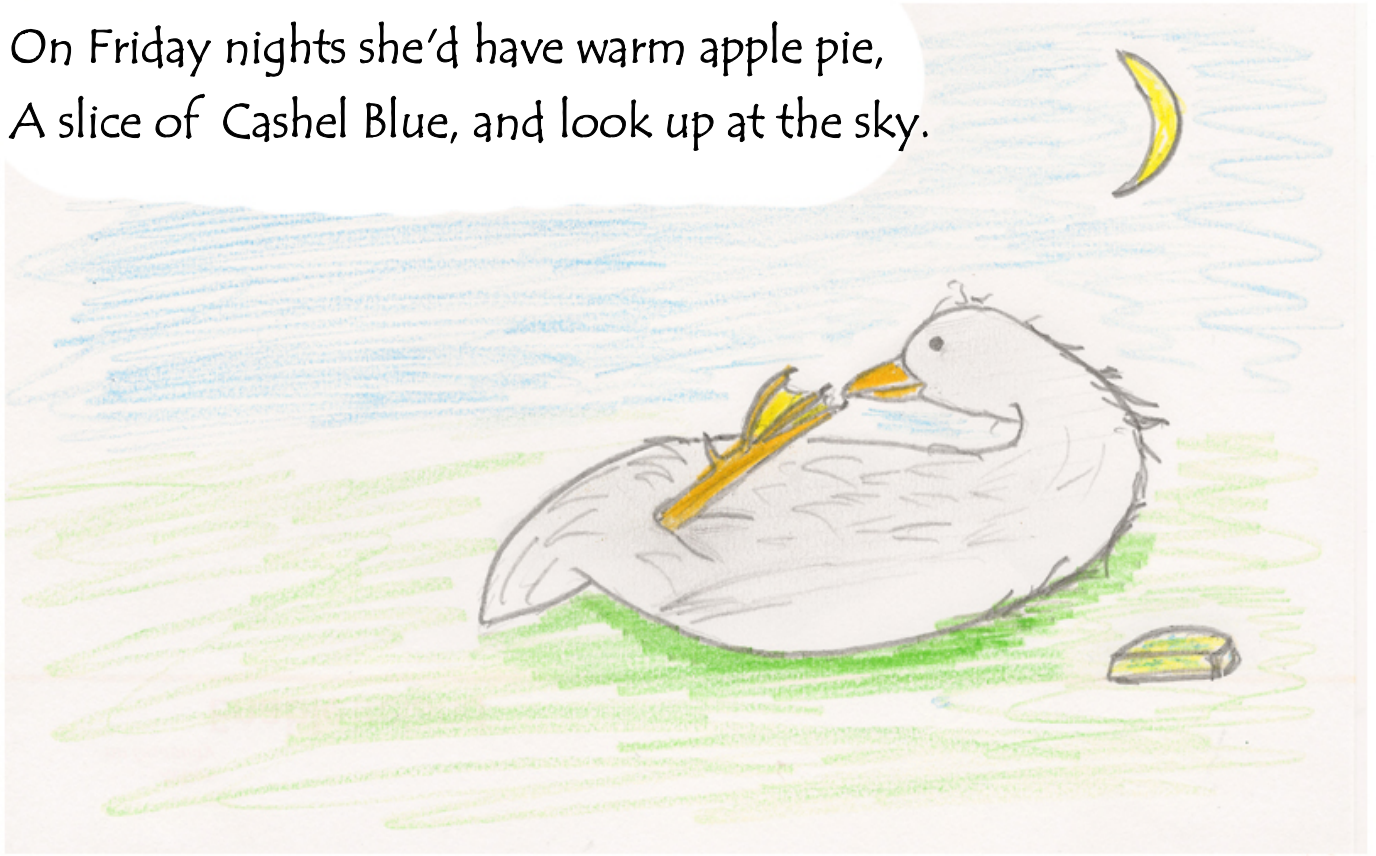
And on her plate, the best of cheese and crackers

A slice of Cashel Blue, and look up at the sky.





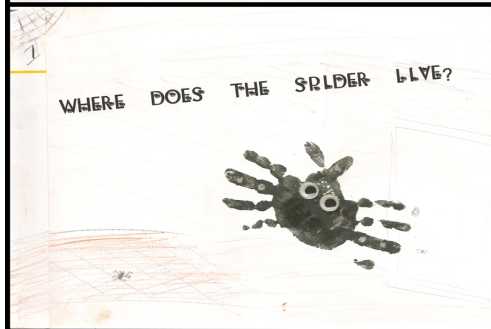
She also liked nuts, berries and seed,
